Saaremaa Harbour is located on the biggest island in Estonia – Saaremaa, in an area of unspoiled nature far from any urban bustle or crowds. The harbour has 2 quays available for cruise vessels and super yachts, accompanied by a quay for auxiliary vessels and a floating berth for small crafts.

The harbour with the depth alongside the quay of 10 meters is capable of servicing ships with the length of up to 200 m. The natural depth of the harbour location is sufficient for receiving the biggest cruise ships sailing in the Baltic Sea.

Due to the harbour's favourable geographical location on the north-western coast of the unique island of Saaremaa, it is the perfect place to stop on your way to Stockholm, Helsinki or Tallinn.

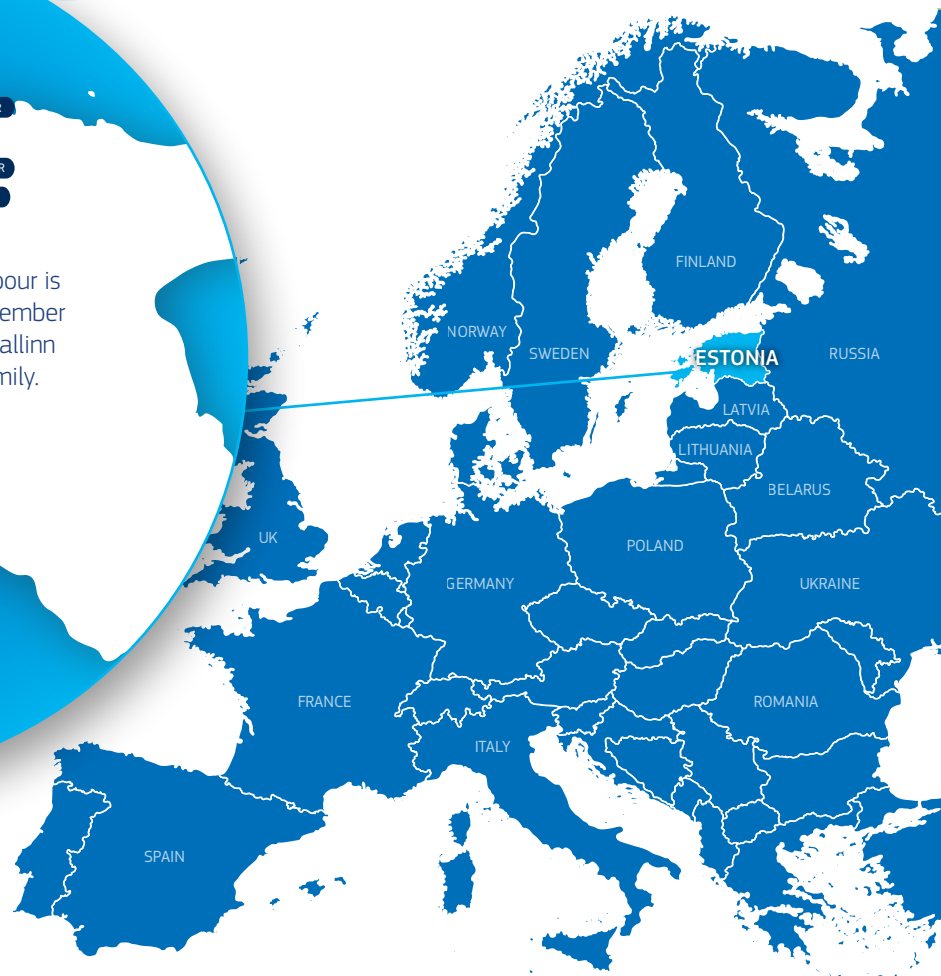

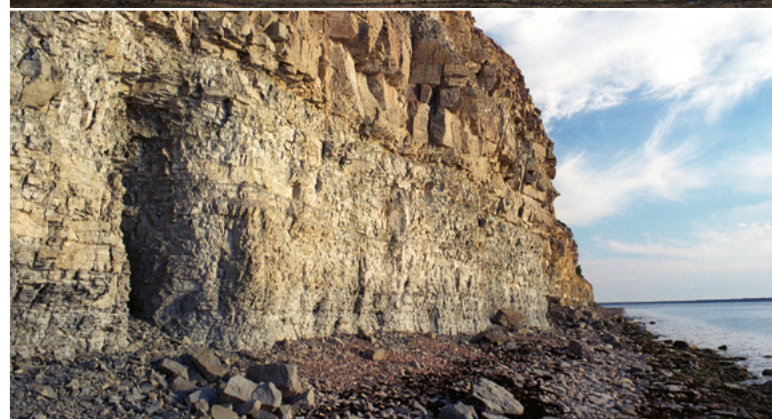
Saaremaa is rich in cultural events and there are activities taking place all over the island.
