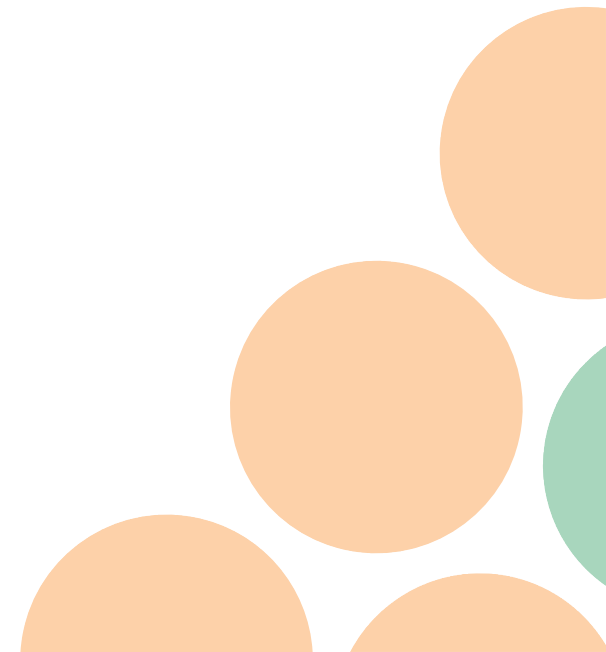

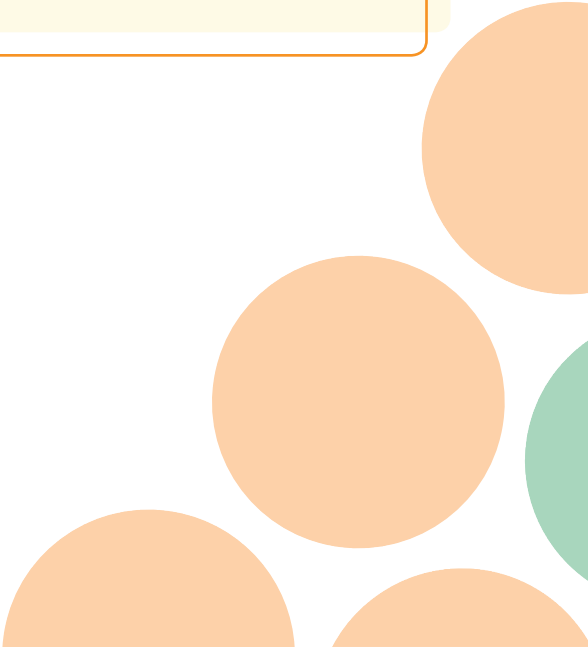

# Hazardous waste

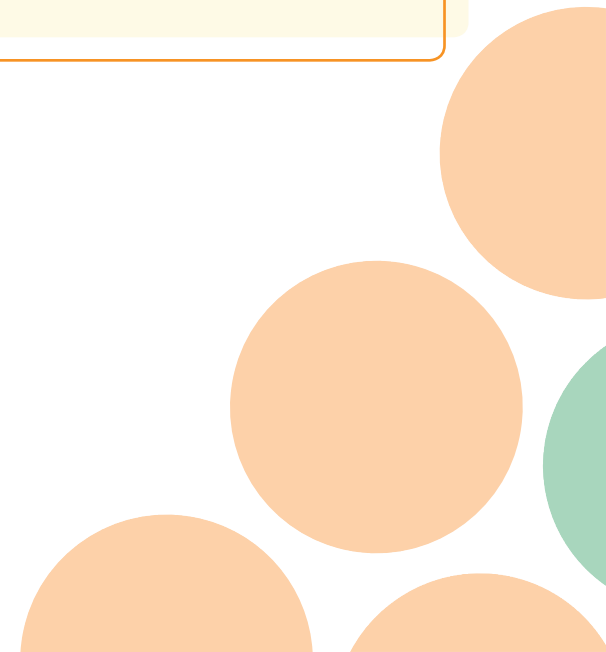
Hazardous waste must be collected in special containers separately from other waste

WASTE TYPE	HOW WASTE IS HANDED OVER	DO NOT MIX WITH
oily rags	waste house / pier 4 and 6 marked containers	mixed domestic waste recyclable waste and packaging problematic products biodegradable waste
paint, varnishes, solvents		
oil filters		
batteries and accumulators		
lamps, fluorecent and energy saving light		
medicines and other medical waste		



# Recyclable waste and packaging

WASTE TYPE	HOW WASTE IS HANDED OVER	DO NOT MIX WITH
cardboard and boxes	common container/ multilift container/pier 4	hazardous waste mixed domestic waste biodegradable waste
waste paper (newspapers, magazines, etc.)		
plastic wrappers		
plastic boxes and bottles		
glass		
tins		



## Scap metal

WASTE TYPE	HOW WASTE IS HANDED OVER	DO NOT MIX WITH
metalwork and other waste metal	waste house/pier 4 and 6 on the basis of a separate order	

## Timber

WASTE TYPE	HOW WASTE IS HANDED OVER	DO NOT MIX WITH
pallets and other timber	waste house/pier 4 and 6 on the basis of a separate order	

## Organic waste

WASTE TYPE	HOW WASTE IS HANDED OVER	DO NOT MIX WITH
food waste	waste house/pier 4 and 6 on the basis of a separate order	hazardous waste mixed domestic waste

## Mixed domestic waste

WASTE TYPE	HOW WASTE IS HANDED OVER	DO NOT MIX WITH
mixed domestic waste	compactor container/pier 4 multilift container/pier 7	

## Other waste

WASTE TYPE	HOW WASTE IS HANDED OVER	DO NOT MIX WITH
tyres	on the basis of a separate order	hazardous and domestic waste
electrical and electronic equipment waste	on the basis of a separate order	hazardous and domestic waste
